

## LIST KSIĘDZA PROBOSZCZA

Drodzy Parafianie i Przyjaciele

Dzisiaj Jezus mówi nam o Sądzie Ostatecznym. I tą metaforeczną ilustracją owiec i kóz pokazuje nam, że będzie to sąd miłości. «Będziemy sądzeni z miłości», mówi nam Święty Jan od Krzyża.

Jezus pokazuje nam, że znaczeniem władzy królewskiej —lub mocy— jest służba innym. On powiedział o sobie samym, że jest Nauczycielem i Panem (por. J 13,13), a także Królem (por. J 18,37), ale sprawował swą władzę myjąc nogi swoim uczniom (por. J 13,4 nast.) i królował dając życie. Jezus króluje, na początku, ze skromnej kołyski (złóbka!), a następnie z bardzo niewygodnego tronu, to znaczy z Krzyża.

Na górze krzyża widniał napis «Jezus Nazarejczyk, Król Żydowski» (J 19,19): co pozorne zostało zanegowane, potwierdziło się w głębszej rzeczywistości tajemnicy Boga, jako że Jezus króluje na Swym Krzyżu i sądzi nas w Swojej miłości. «Będziemy sądzeni z miłości».

## LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners and Friends

Today, Jesus speaks to us about the final judgment. And with that metaphorical image of sheep and goats, He shows us that it will be a judgment of love. Saint John of the Cross tells us: "In the evening of life, we will be judged on love alone."

Jesus shows us that the meaning of kingship - or authority - is serving others. He declared Himself as Teacher and Master (cf. Jn 13:13), and also as King (cf. Jn 18:37), but He exercised His mastery by washing the disciples' feet (cf. Jn 13:4 ff.), and reigned by giving His life. Jesus Christ reigns, first, from a humble cradle (a manger!) and then, from a very uncomfortable throne, that is, the Cross.

On the Cross there was an inscription that said "Jesus the Nazorean, the King of the Jews" (Jn 19:19): what appearances denied was confirmed by the deep reality of the mystery of God, for Jesus reigns from his Cross and He judges us in love. "We will be judged on love alone."

**On the last Sunday of each liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King.** Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical *Quas primas* ("In the first") to respond to growing secularism and atheism. He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing discord among people and nations. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever. During the early twentieth century, in Mexico, Russia, and some parts of Europe, militantly secularistic regimes threatened not just the Catholic Church and its faithful but civilization itself. Pope Pius XI's encyclical gave Catholics hope and—while governments around them crumbled—the assurance that Christ the King shall reign forever. **Jesus Christ "is very truth, and it is from him that truth must be obediently received by all mankind"** (*Quas primas*, 7).

**Christ's kingship is rooted in the Church's teaching on the Incarnation.** Jesus is fully God and fully man. He is both the divine Lord and the man who suffered and died on the Cross. One person of the Trinity unites himself to human nature and reigns over all creation as the Incarnate Son of God. "From this it follows not only that Christ is to be adored by angels and men, but that to him as man angels and men are subject,

and must recognize his empire; by reason of the hypostatic union Christ has power over all creatures" (*Quas primas*, 13). The Church calls us to acknowledge Christ's kingship with our whole lives:

*He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things, and cleave to him alone. He must reign in our bodies and in our members, which should serve as instruments for the interior sanctification of our souls, or to use the words of the Apostle Paul, 'as instruments of justice unto God.'* -*Quas primas*, 33

Today, religious freedom for many people means that we can believe whatever we want in private, but when we enter the public square or the marketplace, we may not speak of anything that relates to our faith. However, the Church acknowledges the reign of Christ, not only privately, but publicly. **This solemnity encourages us to celebrate and live out our faith in public.** "Thus by sermons preached at meetings and in churches, by public adoration of the Blessed Sacrament exposed and by solemn processions, men unite in paying homage to Christ, whom God has given them for their King" (*Quas primas*, 26).

For Christians, when our faith is repeatedly marginalized in public life, we can fall into the habit of compartmentalizing our lives. We love Jesus in our private lives, but we shrink from acknowledging the kingship of Christ in social life. When we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we declare to the world and remind ourselves that Jesus is the Lord of the Church and of the entire universe.


